These items are procured from Eggs Hawaii, Ham Produce & Seafood, Hawaii Foodservice Alliance, H&W Foodservice, Y. Fukunaga Products Ltd., and Y. Hata & Co. Ltd.

One 'Ohana Pack contains enough food to provide several meals throughout the week for a family of 4-6 people. We partner with local businesses and organizations to host 'Ohana Pack distribution events serving anywhere from 30 to 1,500 people in need, primarily individuals and families affected by the COVID-19 economic downturn.

- Fresh produce
- Meat products
- Milk
- Eggs
- Bread

- Local meats (fresh or frozen)
- Local seafood (fresh or frozen)
- Rice
- Pastry items
- Water
- Assorted canned/dry goods and shelf shelf-stable food items
- Other food or promo product donations (bags, snacks, PPEs, etc)
- Recipe cards

#### **Supportive services**

- Flexible dates and times can be arranged
- Our staff will arrange delivery, and refrigerated trucks will transport the food directly to your location
- In-person data collection training prior to your distribution event (if needed)
- No charge to your organization

#### To host an 'Ohana Pack distribution, you'll need to:

 Secure a venue and necessary permits for the event. Aloha Harvest can help with fees as needed.



 Conduct outreach and share info about the event to your target community. Aloha Harvest can also publish on our social media channels if/as needed.




 Secure tents, tables, and chairs for the distribution event. Aloha Harvest can supplement/order as needed.





- Collect and submit recipient data no later than 2 weeks prior to the event. Aloha Harvest creates and hosts the online forms for collecting this data. We'll train your team on how to use the forms and will share all data collected with you.
- Consult with HPD for need of Special Duty Officers. Payment to officers is the responsibility of you as the host agency.





• Set up, break down, and clean up for the event. Aloha Harvest will not be responsible for waste generated during the event, such as pallets, cardboard, plastic wrap, etc.
