RAMP CLOSURE NOTICE

ALTERNATING CLOSURES OF NIMITZ VIADUCT RAMPS NOVEMBER 12 TO DECEMBER 31, 2020 SUNDAY TO THURSDAY: 9 PM TO 5 AM

On the evening of Thursday, November 12, 2020, the gantry located on Nimitz Highway eastbound near Kahauiki Village will begin to cross over the Nimitz Viaduct for guideway installation. This operation requires several ramps to be closed overnight in alternating phases through December 2020. Please see below for details regarding ramp closures and detours.

Motorists are strongly advised to look ahead, not overhead to keep traffic moving safely. Roadway conditions and speed limits will change while traveling through construction areas. Please maintain a safe following distance while on the road as drivers ahead adjust to the traffic plan.

NIMITZ HIGHWAY EASTBOUND NOVEMBER 12 - 23

Nimitz Highway eastbound may be closed between Ke'ehi Lagoon Memorial Park and Kahauiki Village.

Motorists will be detoured to Exit 18B Dillingham Boulevard (East)/Middle Street, then Pu'uhale Road to continue to Nimitz Highway eastbound.



EXIT 18A NOVEMBER 12 - DECEMBER 7

H-1 Freeway Exit 18A Waikiki/ Nimitz Highway eastbound, as well as the HOV lane, may be closed overnight.

Motorists will be detoured to Exit 18B Dillingham Boulevard (East)/Middle Street, then Pu'uhale Road to access Nimitz Highway eastbound and Sand Island Access Road.

NOVEMBER 4 - DECEMBER 31 H-1 Freeway Exit 18A Waikiki/ Nimitz Highway eastbound may be closed. Motorists will be detoured to Exit 18B Dillingham Boulevard (East)/ Middle Street (Detour A), then Pu'uhale Road to access Nimitz Highway and Sand Island Access Road.

The westbound H-1 Freeway on-ramp (Detour B) will be closed past Sand Island Access Road.

Westbound motorists wanting to access the H-1 Freeway will be detoured via Pu'uhale Road, then Dillingham Boulevard/ Kamehameha Highway westbound.





DECEMBER 7 - DECEMBER 31

The westbound on-ramps for the H-1 Freeway as well as Nimitz Highway may be closed in the westbound direction past Sand Island Access Road.

Westbound motorists wanting to access the H-1 Freeway and Nimitz Highway will be detoured via Pu'uhale Road, then Dillingham Boulevard/ Kamehameha Highway.
