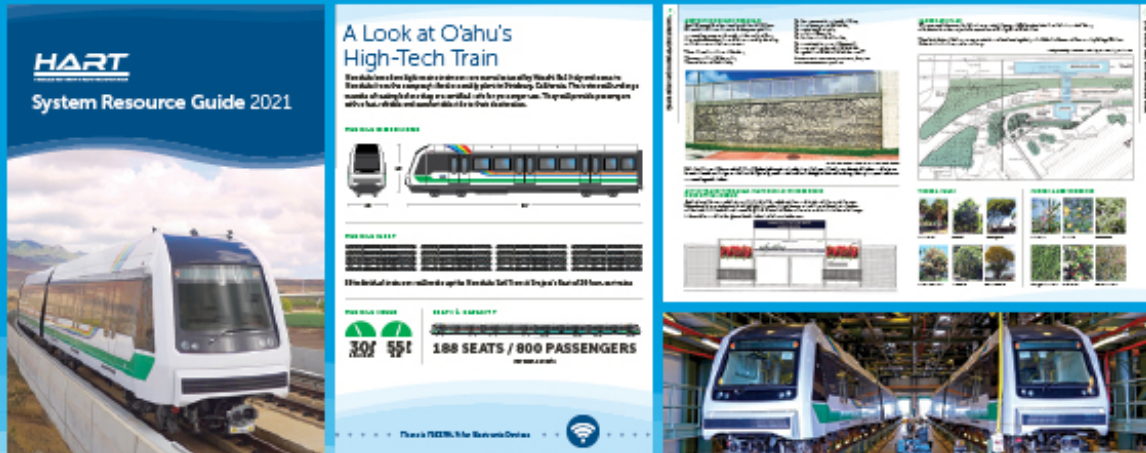

Facilities Tour with Representative Gene Ward

On Monday, May 3, 2021, HART and Hitachi Rail Honolulu hosted State Representative Gene Ward and his staff on a facilities tour of the Rail Operations Center (ROC) and the Hālaulani (Leeward Community College) Station. The ROC is a 43-acre site off Farrington Highway between Leeward Community College and Waipahu High School that includes four major structures: the Operations and Servicing Building, the Maintenance of Way Building, the Train Wash Facility and the Wheel Truing Building.

While touring the ROC, guests were able to participate in a walking tour of the Train Control Room where personnel monitor and control train movement through the entire system 24/7. Visitors were also able to view the service bays where train maintenance and inspections occur.

Monday Traffic Update

Beginning Monday May 17, Kamehameha Highway westbound will be reduced to two travel lanes between the Kalihi Stream and Middle Street. This travel lane reduction will be in place 24/7 through June 2021 and is required to support column construction for the Honolulu Rail Transit Project.

Access will be maintained to the Nimitz Highway westbound on-ramp and the H-1 Freeway westbound on-ramp. HART would like to remind motorists to be mindful of changing roadway conditions in construction zones. Please remain patient and alert while navigating through construction zones and obey all posted signage.
