YOU CAN STILL HAVE YOUR SAY

The 2022 Legislative Session adjourned sine die on May 5, 2022, and the bills have been sent to Governor Ige to sign into law or to veto.

Governor Ige must notify the Legislature by **June 27, 2022**, if he intends to veto a bill. Bills that Governor Ige indicated he would veto should be vetoed by him on July 12, 2022. Otherwise, the bill becomes law on **July 12, 2022**, with or without his signature.

However, it is not too late to express your opinion on a bill that has been passed to the Governor. You may submit comments to the Governor regarding legislation that has been sent to him by filling out a form and submitting it to him at this <https://governor.hawaii.gov/contact-us/comments-on-legislation/>, or call (808) 586-0034.
