2. All entries must be approved by the Parade Committee.
3. All participants must abide by the Rules and Regulations set by the Parade Committee.
4. Participants must be in good physical condition. The route is approximately 2 miles and involves hills.
5. Participants agree to participate at own risk. The Parade & Fun Fair Committee and the Aiea Community Association will not be liable for any illness or injuries related to this event.
6. Children under the age of 12 should be accompanied by an adult (21 years of age or older).
7. Transportation to and from the parade is the responsibility of the participant.
8. Parade begins at 9:00 am at Pearlridge Elementary School. Parade participants should arrive no later than 8:15 am.
9. The parade begins at Pearlridge Park (Pearlridge Elementary), heads east on Moanalua Road in the mauka lanes, past Pearlridge Shopping Center, turns left on to Kaamilo St, right on to Ulune St. and ends at the old Sugar Mill site on Halewiliko St. Walkers and all vehicles will proceed to the back of the Sugar Mill Site. Parking will be available for the parade vehicles. Approximate walking time: 1 hour
