**Monday Traffic Update** 



**Beginning the week of March 20, 2023**, HART and its Dillingham Utilities Relocation contractor, Nan, Inc., will extend work areas on Dillingham Boulevard from Alakawa Street to Kaaahi Street.

- Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard between Middle Street and Kaaahi Street will operate with one westbound and one eastbound travel lane, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Left turns from Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard are restricted, except for the westbound left turn from Dillingham Boulevard onto Alakawa Street, which will remain open.
- Left turns onto Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham are permitted only at intersections and signalized cross streets. Left turns from mid-block driveways onto Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard are restricted.
- Intersections may be intermittently closed overnight at various locations, as needed, during nighttime work hours from 7 pm to 5 am.

Driveway access will be maintained along Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard.

Bus stop locations near designated work zones may be temporarily relocated.

Travel lanes may be shifted in various areas. Dedicated bus pullout lanes have been implemented to allow buses to service passengers, while allowing through-traffic to maintain travel. Please observe and obey traffic signage through construction zones.

Residents and businesses near work zones may experience elevated levels of noise during operating hours. Please anticipate and plan for delays and travel detours, observe all traffic signs and drive with caution.
