Monday Traffic Update



HART and Nan, Inc. would like to remind motorists, residents and area businesses of ongoing travel lane modifications on Kamehameha Highway at the Middle Street intersection through Dillingham Boulevard at the Kaaahi Street intersection.

Beginning the week of March 20, 2023, HART and its contractor, Nan, Inc., will be extending the work

areas on Dillingham Boulevard from Alakawa Street to Kaaahi Street. The current one-lane configuration will extend continuously from Middle Street to Kaaahi Street.

- Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard will operate with one westbound and one eastbound travel lane, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Left turns are restricted for motorists traveling on Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard, and from driveways.
- Intersecting streets along the corridor in the mauka and makai direction will be closed, as needed, during nighttime work hours from 7 pm to 5 am.
- Driveway access will be maintained along Kamehameha Highway and Dillingham Boulevard.
- Bus stop locations near designated work zones may be temporarily relocated.

Travel lanes may be shifted in various areas. Dedicated bus pullout lanes have been implemented to allow buses to service passengers, while allowing through-traffic to maintain travel. Please observe and obey traffic signage through construction zones.

Residents and businesses near work zones may experience elevated levels of noise during operating hours. Please anticipate and plan for delays and travel detours, observe all traffic signs and drive with caution.
