HART and the Frank V. Coluccio Construction Company (FVCCC) would like to inform motorists of ongoing and intermittent lane closures along Nimitz Highway, Ala Moana Boulevard and Halekauwila Street to facilitate Downtown Utilities Relocation (CCUR III) work.

The left turn from Ala Moana Boulevard eastbound onto Halekauwila Street may be intermittently closed Mondays through Saturdays, between 8:30 am to 6 pm. This left turn closure will occur as needed through February 2024.

Motorists seeking access to Halekauwila Street from Ala Moana Boulevard will be detoured further east to South Street, then Queen Street towards Richards Street. Motorists may also utilize Alakea Street to access Queen Street and Richards Street towards Halekauwila Street.

Driveway and business access will be maintained near the designated work zones.
