#### Missing and Faded Street Name Signs in Makalapa

Mahalo to DFM for replacing the faded street name signs in the Makalapa area, as well as their ongoing efforts for the continued maintenance of signs throughout the city.

#### Fencing Blocking Sidewalk at Webling Elementary School

Due to a complaint that construction fencing and materials were blocking the sidewalk at the entrance to Webling Elementary School Councilmember Cordero submitted an inquiry to the Navy to look into the matter. The Navy responded that their contractor temporarily set up the fencing on Friday, February 1, in preparation for the potential heavy winds and rains that were expected to occur during that weekend, as measures to prevent any water or run-off from entering the properties of nearby homeowners. For additional safety while the fence was extended and partially blocking the sidewalk, barriers and signs were erected to indicate that the sidewalk was closed.

On Monday, February 5, the fencing was moved back to its standard position to allow for a clear path for students and parents to use the sidewalk, and the "Sidewalk Closed" signs were removed.

### EARLY RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSES AND STATE IDS

The Department of Customer Services is reminding O'ahu residents whose driver's licenses and state identification cards will expire this year that they can renew these credentials up to six months in advance. These cardholders will be able to keep the same expiration date, which is their birthday month and day, plus whatever number of years to which they are entitled. There is no loss of time by renewing expiring driver's licenses or state IDs make an appointment, please alohaq.honolulu.gov/?lp. # CLOSURE OF PICKLEBALL COURTS AT KE'EHI LAGOON FOR IMPROVEMENTS





On January 22, the Department of Parks and Recreation temporarily closed the pickleball courts at Ke'ehi Lagoon to install fencing in between the stacked courts. The installation is estimated to take about six weeks to complete, weather permitting, with the entire complex expected to reopen by mid-March 2024. This work is part of a larger effort by the City to add more pickleball courts and modify existing facilities to accommodate the fastest growing sport in the country.
