As the NCTF-RH commander, Collins will continue to oversee the command's mission to decommission the underground storage tanks and close the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility, long-term environmental remediation in and around Red Hill, and ongoing public engagement and communication.

Rear Adm. Marc Williams still serves as the NCTF-RH deputy commander overseeing daily task force operations.







Pipeline Cleaning Operations begin at Red Hill

The Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill team recently began pipeline cleaning operations to prepare for pipeline removal at the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility this year.

The pipes are cleaned through a process called "pigging."

During pigging, a pipe-sized foam cylinder is pushed or pulled through the pipes several times until the pipes are cleared.

Throughout the process, additional spill protection measures are put in place. The Navy will provide extensive oversight of contractors to maintain the safety of the environment.

Once the pigging is complete, a Marine Chemist will inspect the pipe to certify it is ready for cutting and removal. Pipe material will be recycled on the U.S. mainland.


