



# RED HILL HIGHLIGHTS

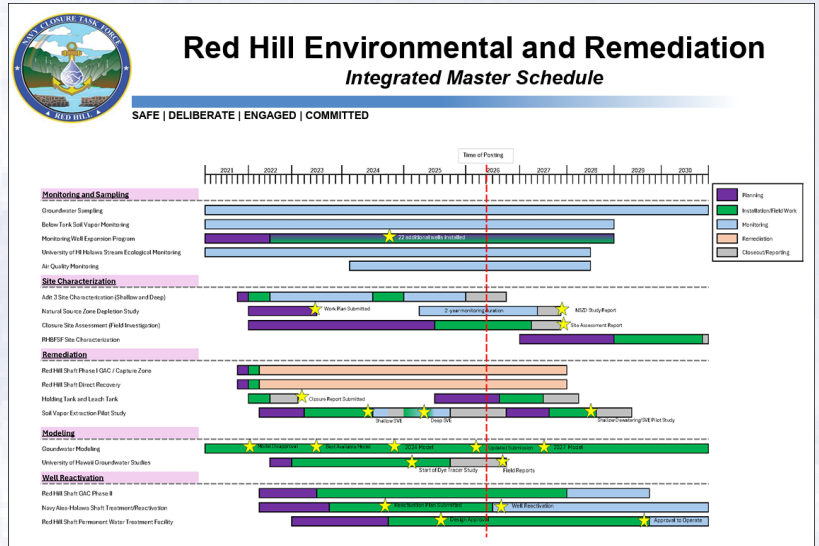

The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.

## Environmental Remediation Action Schedule Available on JBPBH Safe Waters Website

Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill continues to inform the community by sharing the Environmental Remediation Actions Schedule on the Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam Safe waters website. The schedule shows the steady progress of the Navy's efforts to remediate the environment around Red Hill.

The schedule includes a timeline for monitoring and sampling, site assessment, remediation, groundwater modeling, and well recovery. Each action on the calendar is color coded by the type of work and approximate duration. ## NCTF-RH to Conduct Erosion Control at Red Hill to Ensure Personnel Safety

As part of its ongoing commitment to personnel safety, NCTF-RH is scheduled to begin erosion control efforts at the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) beginning in June, which may cause an increase in noise in the surrounding community through Fall 2027.

To ensure the long-term stability of the hillside, crews must safely break apart large, loose boulders to facilitate their removal and prepare the site for long term erosion controls, such as reinforced netting. This critical phase of the project may temporarily create louder-than-average noise during normal working hours in the surrounding community. These efforts also ensure the continued protection of the local community.
